X-tra Giving for October will benefit Operation Hope-Vista homeless shelter. This organization provides a safe and comprehensive program to help homeless families and single women transition to a self-sustaining life and stable housing for themselves. Jean Cole's vision of having a year-round shelter came to fruition this year. Supplies needed are the individual boxes of spoons and forks that Costco sells. Knives not needed. Also needed are quart, sandwich, and gallon-size zip lock bags, paper towels, Murphy's Oil, Spic-n-Span cleaner, Lysol SPRAY, bowls for cereal and soups (deep), tall trash can bags, Styrofoam cups and diapers (sizes 3 or 4).
